Rules and Regulations

The main objective of this Forum is to get better acquainted with Armenian cultural heritage. To help the program run as smoothly as possible, please take note of the following regulations

- 1. Passports must be handed to the Committee. While it is not mandatory, it is highly recommended that participants also hand in the bulk of their money to the organizers for safekeeping. The passports and monies will be kept at a vault located in the hotel and a senior Forum representative will be the person with sole access to that vault. Participants will have access to the vault at set hours during the day.
- Participants need to attend all lectures, workshops and activities organized by the Committee. Furthermore, they must respect the schedule by being present at least five minutes prior to the start of the activity.
- 3. No arrangements should be made to meet with relatives and friends during the times allotted for lectures, workshops and other activities. Specific times for such visits have already been scheduled throughout the duration of the Forum.
- 4. While we do want the participants to enjoy Yerevan's night life, staying up too late might prevent them from keeping up with the daily schedules of activities. Please note that for several events and activities taking place outside of the Forum grounds, buses will be leaving exactly at the set time without waiting for latecomers.
- 5. Participants must keep their rooms tidy. Clothing must either be kept in the closet or in suitcases.
- 6. The supervisor(s) must be informed whenever a participant needs to leave the guesthouse for a valid reason or to return later than the scheduled time. Although Yerevan is generally a safe place, it is advisable to go out in groups.
- Prior to their departure the participants must pay for all of their local and international communications. All participants must respect these rules and regulations.


